The Mayor and Board of Council of the Town of Lake Arthur met this day in special meeting. Notice of the meeting was duly exercised as per requirements of open meeting law. Mayor Sherry Crochet called the meeting to order at 2:02 p.m. Council Member Auldon Robinson gave the invocation and Mayor Sherry Crochet led the Pledge of Allegiance. Town Clerk, Mindy Marcantel called roll and the following were present: Council Members: David Hanks; Auldon Robinson; Ricky Monceaux; Sampson LeJeune; and Mayor Sherry Crochet. Absent: Robert Palermo. Also attending, Town Clerk, Mindy Marcantel; Representative of Jennings Daily News and The American Press, six citizens, and guests: Guest-Amber Hymel, Tax Administrator Jefferson Davis Parish School Board Sales & Use Tax Office. Guest-David Guidry and Mr. Guidry to discuss the future ownership of the Regatta LA Seafood and Steakhouse and the Town of Lake Arthur Cooperative Endeavor Agreement.

It was motioned by David Hanks, seconded by Ricky Monceaux to approve minutes from April 3, 2019 meeting as submitted. A roll call vote was taken. The motion carried unanimously.

It was motioned by David Hanks, seconded by Ricky Monceaux to approve A Resolution in Opposition of All Proposed Legislation that Transfers the Administration and Collection of Local Sales & Use Taxes to the Louisiana Department of Revenue. A roll call vote was taken. The motion carried unanimously.

It was motioned by Sampson LeJeune, seconded by Ricky Monceaux to approve A Resolution for Exemption of Sales Tax on "Crawfish Bait and Feed" only for persons actively involved in Business of Crawfishing. A roll call was taken. The motion carried unanimously.

It was motioned by Ricky Monceaux, seconded by Auldon Robinson to Adopt Ordinance No. 588, an Ordinance Adding Stop Signs on Third Street at the Intersection of Orange and Third Street would establish a Four Way Stop and providing for the violation thereof. A roll call was taken. The motion failed to pass with three NAYS and one YEA.

It was motioned by Sampson LeJeune, seconded by Ricky Monceaux to adjourn meeting. The meeting was adjourned at P.M. A roll call was taken. Motion carried unanimously.
