

PUBLIC HEARING

MARCH 2, 2020 AT 6:00 PM

A public hearing was held on March 2, 2020 at 6:00 p.m. in the Lake Arthur City Hall at 102 Arthur Ave, Lake Arthur, Louisiana, in which notice of the meeting was duly exercised as per requirements of open meeting law. Present at the Public Hearing was Mayor Crochet, Council Members: David Hanks, Roberta Palermo, Sampson LeJeune, Ricky Monceaux, and Auldon Robinson. Also attending Town Clerk Mindy Marcantel and Representative of Lake Charles American Press. There were fourteen citizens present. Mayor Crochet called the public hearing to order at which time she read the Ordinances.

Adopt Ordinance No. 591, An Ordinance Regulating Golf Carts and Adopt Ordinance NO. 592, Amending Ordinance No. 498, An ordinance prohibiting certain animals within city limits of Lake Arthur. Mayor Crochet asked if there were any comments or questions. Comments and questions were heard on matter. Mayor Crochet closed the public hearing at 6:01 pm.

The Mayor and Board of Council of the Town of Lake Arthur met this day in regular meeting. Notice of the meeting was duly exercised as per requirements of open meeting law. Mayor Sherry Crochet called the regular meeting to order at 6:02 p.m. Auldon Robinson gave the invocation and Mayor Sherry Crochet led the Pledge of Allegiance. Town Clerk Mindy Marcantel called roll and the following present: Council Members: David Hanks, Ricky Monceaux, Sampson Lejeune, Roberta Palermo, Auldon Robinson and Mayor Sherry Crochet. Also attending, Town Clerk, Mindy Marcantel, Representative from the American Press and fourteen citizens. Mayor Crochet recognized guest, Terry Thibodeaux, who spoke against passing Ordinance No. 592.

It was motioned by Sampson LeJeune, seconded by David Hanks to adopt the agenda. A roll call was taken. The motion carried unanimously.

It was motioned by Auldon Robinson, seconded by Davis Hanks to approve minutes from regular meeting held on February 5, 2020 as submitted. A roll call vote was taken. The motion carried unanimously.

It was moved by Ricky Monceaux, seconded by Auldon Robinson to approve contract between the Town of Lake Arthur and Alex Guillory, Bluewing Civil Consulting, LLC for Water Meter Project. A roll call vote was taken. The motion carried unanimously.

It was moved by Sampson LeJeune, seconded by David Hanks to approve Cooperative Endeavor Agreement with and between Town of Lake Arthur and Last Resort Show, Stewart Daigle A roll call was taken. The motion carried unanimously.

It was moved by Ricky Monceaux, seconded by Auldon Robinson to adopt Ordinance No. 591, An Ordinance Regulating Golf Carts Within City Limits Town of Lake Arthur, Louisiana. A roll call was taken. The motion carried unanimously.

It was moved by Ricky Monceaux, seconded by Sampson LeJeune to adopt Ordinance No. 592, Amending Ordinance No. 498, An Ordinance Prohibiting Certain Animals Within City Limits of Lake Arthur, Louisiana A roll call was taken. There were four yeas and one nay vote. Motion passed.

It was moved by Sampson LeJeune, seconded Auldon Robinson to approve Resolution to Adopt R.S. 39:1600 © for the Purchase of Used Equipment 2008 Peterbilt Rear Loader Garbage Truck. A roll call was taken. The motion carried unanimously.

It was moved by Sampson LeJeune, seconded Roberta Palermo to approve the withdrawal of \$73,512.48 from the Town of Lake Arthur Solid Waste Imma Account for expense of the 2008 Peterbilt Rear Loader Garbage Truck from Reliance Truck & Equipment. A roll call was taken. The motion carried unanimously.

It was moved by Ricky Monceaux, seconded Roberta Palermo to approve Resolution to enter Cooperative Use Agreement Ferguson Enterprises, LLC/Mueller Systems Self-Read Water Meters Supply Contract Town of Lake Arthur RFP #05-19 to purchase water meters. A roll call was taken. The motion carried unanimously.

It was moved by Auldon Robinson, seconded by Roberta Palermo to approve, per the request of Chief of Police, Kobi Turner, to hire Monica Schexnider, as Full-Time Dispatcher

Mayor Crochet open the floor for announcements. Mayor Crochet stated the Lake Arthur Mardi Gras run and parade was awesome this year.

It was motioned by Auldon Robinson, seconded by Roberta Palermo to adjourn meeting at 6:31 pm. A roll call vote was taken. The motion carried unanimously.
